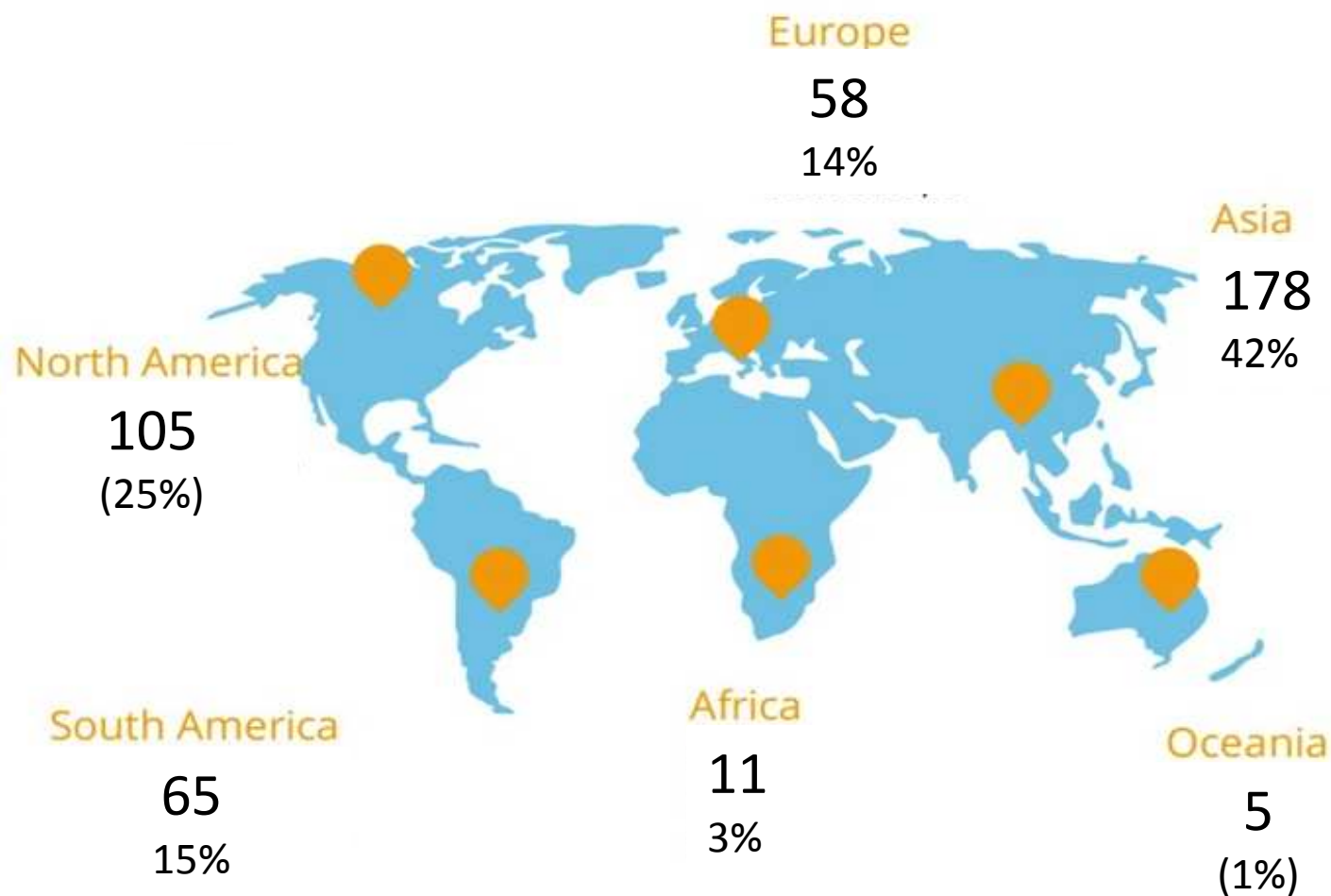

Introducing the carbonn Registry (i)



- The carbonn Climate Registry (cCR) is a global reporting platform of local and subnational climate action
- Launched at the World Mayors Summit on Climate in Mexico City on 21 Nov. 2010 (COP 16 in Cancun)

3 areas of reporting:

Commitments
(Climate and Energy)

Performances
(GHG inventories)

Actions
(Adaptation and Mitigation)

Introducing the carbonn Registry (ii)



- Open and free use by any **local AND subnational government** (region, province, state)
- **Reporting can be done at any time** - encouraged to update by mid-May and by mid-October.
- **Analyses made twice a year** – used towards the UNFCCC and international climate negotiations
- Operated by the **Bonn Center for Local Climate Action and Reporting** (carbonn Center).



Purpose of the cCCR (i)

Credibility	Promotes Transparency & Accountability of commitments/targets and GHG developments
Verification	Improves Measurable, Reportable, Verifiable (MRV) local climate action
Recognition	Leaders are recognised, promoted, used at events to illustrate
Inspiration	Thousands of entries – mitigation and adaptation, diverse examples, ambitions shared

Values of the cCR

- a) A common platform for cities and regions in the **Global South and North**
- b) Addresses climate change mitigation / adaptation
- c) Aims to strengthen **credibility of local planning and action** – thereby easing **access to financing**
- d) Enables **information sharing**, identifying **good practice**, raising level of **ambition**
- e) Framework for further developing an **MRV approach** – **towards standardization**
- f) **Direct input into UNFCCC process** through ICLEI
